We are Janelle Babington and Penny Eims, animal welfare petitioners with AnimalVictory.org. We have created a petition asking for Phil Savelli to receive the maximum sentence for the animal cruelty charge stemming from his June 2 killing of a 10-month-old Yorkshire terrier puppy named Coco.

It is our understanding that Savelli dunked Coco in a sink full of water and then placed her into a freezer – not once, but twice. The puppy suffered greatly before freezing to death. This is a despicable act of cruelty which we, and our supporters, hope to see treated with the seriousness that it deserves.

We hope to see Goddard's Law, making this animal cruelty charge a felony, applied to this case; it is imperative that Phil Savelli face the maximum penalty for his actions. A plea deal would only serve to diminish the severity of his crime. Additionally, the supporters of this petition want the court to prohibit Savelli from owning, or living with, animals in the future. We also demand a full mental evaluation and treatment if applicable.

We thank you for your hard work on this case and hope to hear back from your office with an update. We will touch base again soon if we do not hear back from you.
